



POP-UP #2-BEAK

- 1. Fold cardstock/paper in half.
- 2. Cut a horizontal slit in the center of the fold.
- 3. Crease the top of the slit at a right angle.
- 4. Fold back over.
- 5. Crease the bottom of the slit at a right angle.
- 6. Unfold and push the angles through to the other side.




POP-UP #3-CUBE FOLD

- 1. Fold cardstock/paper in half
- 2. Cut TWO horizontal slits in the fold at least two inches apart.
- 3. Fold back the paper between the slits. Crease well.
- Push through to the other side.



POP-UP #4-POP UP POSIES

- Fold Cardstock in half and set aside.
- 2. Cut nine identical squares out of construction paper.
- With each piece of square paper, fold back the paper making a triangle
- 4. Fold into a second triangle
- 5. Fold into a third triangle



POP-UP #4-POSIES CONT.

- Using a pencil, draw a curved shape at the top of the triangle that is even on both folded sides.
- 7. Cut out the curved lines.
- 8. Unfold the Posey
- Pesign the Posey however you choose. Just leave one section of the Posey blank.
- 10. Cut out the blank section
- 11. Glue the bottom of the petal to the right of the empty section to the top of the petal to the left of the empty section. Press and let dry. Repeat for all of the Posies.
- Follow directions on the next page for gluing the Posies together and to the card.

The different colors below represent different posies and how they should be placed on the base (yellow) posey. Only place glue as it is shown on the illustration. Liquid glue is best
